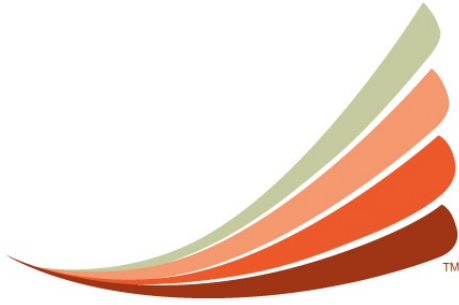

Charitable IRA Rollover: An Opportunity to Reduce Taxes and Support Local Charities through the Henry County Community Foundation

In December of 2015, Congress passed a permanent extension of the IRA Charitable Rollover provision which, if you are age 70½ or older, makes it easy to make tax-free distributions to the Henry County Community Foundation (HCCF) (up to \$100,000 per year) from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA).

The gift must be donated to the Henry County Community Foundation from a qualified traditional or Roth IRA. If you have a different type of qualified retirement plan, your gift must be transferred (tax-free) to a traditional or Roth IRA before donating to the community foundation.

As a reminder, these funds do qualify as your required minimum distribution for the year. It is not permissible to receive a further charitable deduction for this gift, since the funds will not be taxed upon distribution.

Now it's easier than ever to make the gift of a lifetime.

Henry County Community Foundation can help turn your individual retirement accounts (IRAs) into tax-saving charitable gifts. New tax benefits allow more people to experience the joy of giving during their lifetimes.

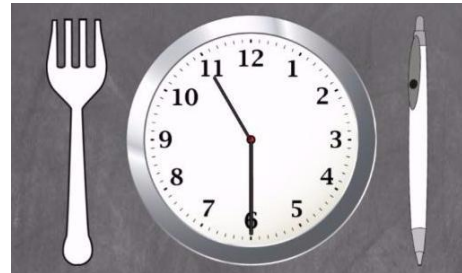
