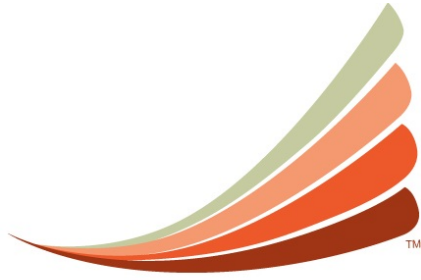

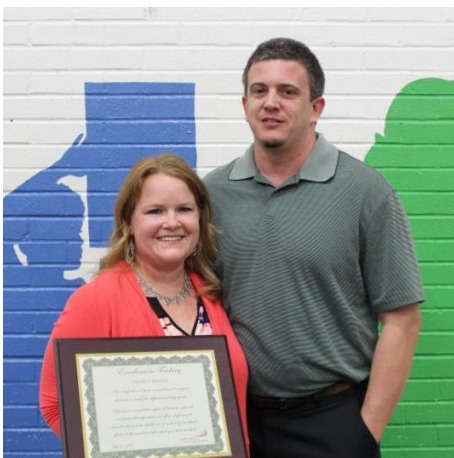

The Teacher Excellence Award is designed to recognize teachers who have demonstrated an unusual commitment to inspire students to reach for difficult and lofty goals. Persons nominated will have earned the respect of students, parents and peers through sustained effort, high moral standards and the likelihood of enduring beneficial effects on the students with which they have worked.

Any current full-time teacher of a public, not-for-profit school within Henry County is eligible for nomination. Any persons including parents, students, peers and citizens of the

community may make nominations. Someone who has had a direct experience with the nominee must submit the online nomination form.

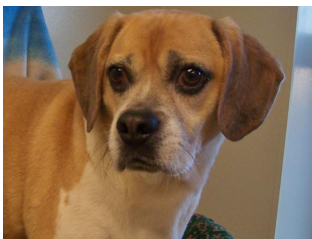

Henry County Humane Society Pat's Pet Clinic

Named after shelter advocate Pat Burton, in the spring 2018 **Choose Henry** grant cycle, the Henry County Humane Society requested funds for Pat's Pet Clinic, a low-cost veterinary clinic at the animal shelter. Granted \$7,500 to do so, the funds assisted with the purchase of medical equipment for the clinic.

Henry County has a great need for the veterinary clinic, which allows all animals at the shelter to be spayed and neutered before being adopted, as well as provide low-cost medical services to animals in need of vaccinations and other services. The New Castle-Henry County Animal Shelter is a "no kill" facility, meaning that all animals taken in by the

shelter are either put up for adoption or sent to rescues in other communities to be adopted.

The low-cost clinic provides necessary veterinarian care to the stray and abandoned animals housed at the animal shelter. Also open to the public, animal lovers are provided services on a sliding scale regardless of income, allowing the clinic to deliver affordable care to all of Henry County. The clinic is also used as a training tool for the New Castle Career Center's Vet Science Program, allowing students to gain additional opportunities in the field of animal studies through internships at the clinic. The Henry County Humane Society was incorporated in 1969, with the Animal Shelter in operation since 1986.
