

### Fighting Food Insecurities

Recently, Boar's Head Provisions Co., Inc. made a large donation of meat, cheese, and various snack items to God's Grain Bin to help local residents in need.

The pantry has experienced a 460% increase in food distribution, from helping 150 families per month to now 700 families per month due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

According to Owen Wyant, President of God's Grain Bin, the donation came at the most opportune time



and he is grateful for the partnership with a local business. “Boar’s Head has been a great support to us,” he said. “They reached out to us wanting to help and our great volunteers got the work done.”


