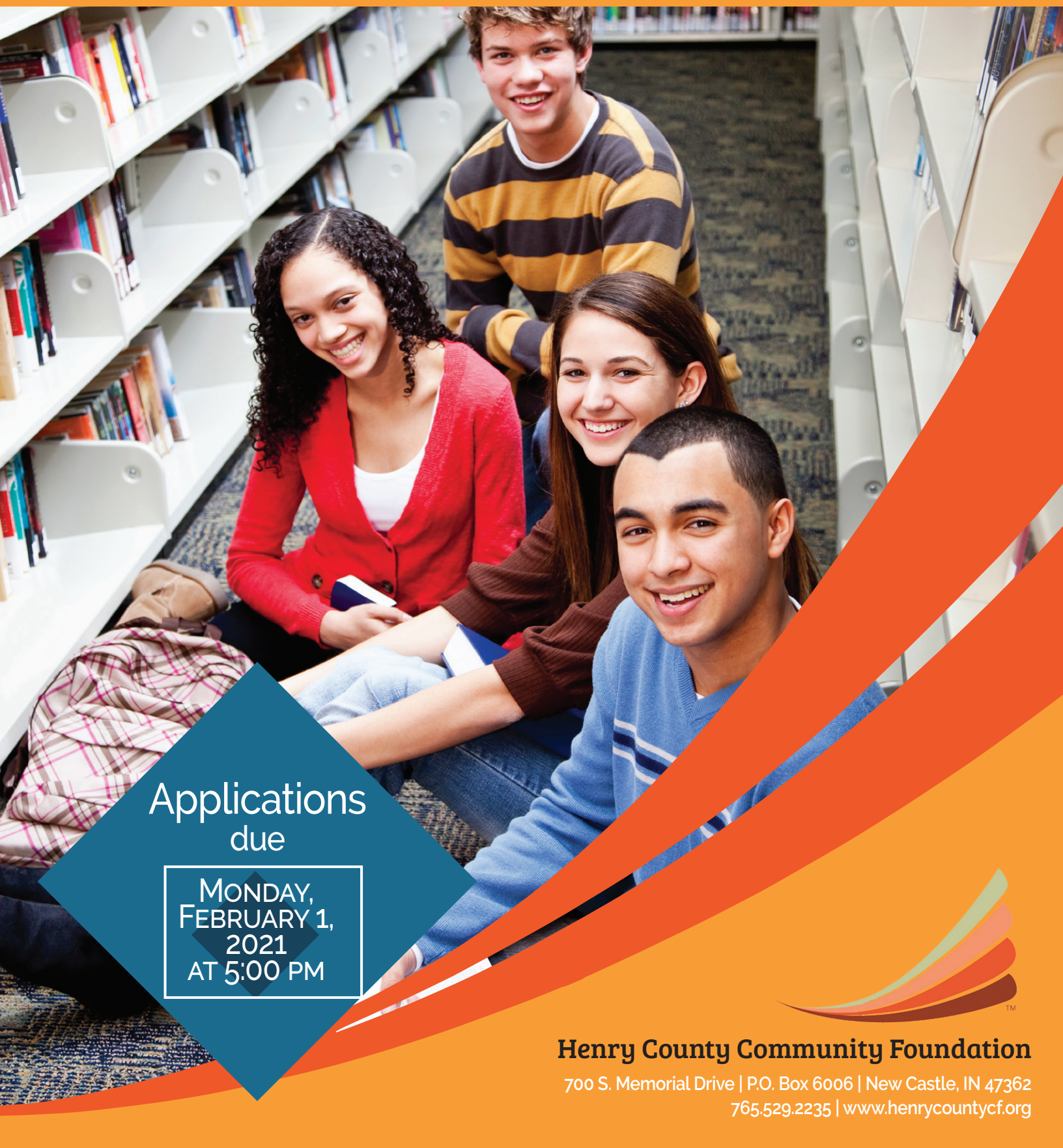

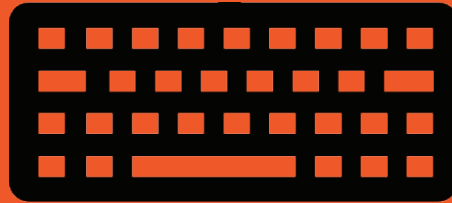

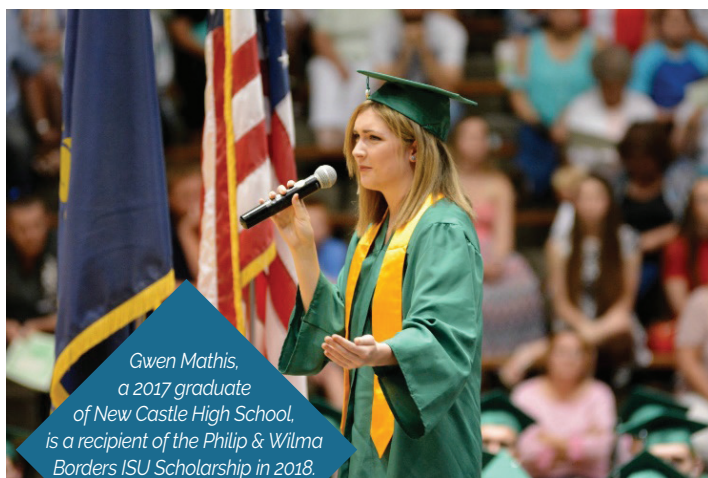

How to Apply

HCCF offers scholarships for graduating high school seniors, college students, non-traditional students, home-schooled students, and those who are seeking a post-secondary certification.

You Will Need

All scholarship applications are online using a Universal Application and require the following:

- ☐ Your complete transcript, including Fall 2020 grades, GPA, and class rank
- ☐ College Acceptance Letter
- ☐ Parent & Student Income and Tax Information
- ☐ List of employment, community service, and extracurricular activities
- ☐ Two letters of recommendation

1. Please be sure to read the list of scholarships in the following pages to determine your eligibility and the scholarships' requirements. Each scholarship is listed on pages 6-7 and is categorized by the following: for students graduating from the five Henry County high schools, Henry County residents, Henry County high school graduates (current or past), college students, and scholarships for home-schooled students. Scholarships are also listed on the HCCF website at **www.henrycountycf.org** under "Scholarships" and then "Scholarship Search."
2. Visit our website to access the online application. When you go to Foundant Technologies for the first time, you will be asked to create a new account using your personal email and a unique password. Please be sure to keep track of your log-in information as you will need it whenever you want to edit or submit an application. You can use the Applicant Checklist (page 45) to write down your information.
3. Please read all application instructions. The HCCF Universal Application allows students to fill out a single application, saving time as they are matched to scholarships for which they meet the eligibility requirements. Students will no longer need to submit a separate scholarship application to each fund for which they are eligible.
4. Each Universal Application requires two (2) letters of recommendation, which must be obtained through the Request section of the online application. Applicants will send out an email request for references to fill out an online form through a Foundant Technologies link, with the option to upload a typed or scanned letter. Recommendations may **NOT** be submitted by the student or provided by a family member. Acceptable recommendations include those from teachers and school officials, your employer, minister, coach, etc.

A scholarship application will only be considered when it has been completed by meeting all the requirements and submitted by 5:00 PM on MONDAY, FEBRUARY 1, 2021.

Note: The Summer College Scholarship deadline is **FRIDAY, JUNE 4, 2021 at 5:00 PM**. College student only scholarships are due at this time. Please see the scholarship key for college student only scholarships.



Frequently Asked Questions

WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO APPLY?

Each scholarship fund has specific eligibility criteria defined by the donor when the fund was established. Please read through the scholarships to see if you are eligible. A complete list of scholarships with criteria is available on pages 8-42 of the scholarship booklet.

HOW DO I APPLY?

Visit our website at www.henrycountycf.org to access the Universal Application once it becomes available online on November 2, 2020.

HOW MUCH DOES IT COST TO APPLY FOR A SCHOLARSHIP?

There is no charge to apply for any HCCF scholarship.

ARE THE SCHOLARSHIPS AWARDED SUFFICIENT TO PAY THE COST OF MY COLLEGE EDUCATION?

No. These scholarships are intended to provide only partial support. In addition to applying for HCCF scholarships, you should look into other financial aid resources including federal and state grants, institutional scholarships, and loans. Your college or university's financial aid office can help you put together a complete financial aid package.

IF I AM AWARDED A SCHOLARSHIP, HOW MUCH WILL I RECEIVE?

Scholarship grants are generated from the income earned from endowed (permanent) funds administered by HCCF and are based on a percentage of income earned. Most scholarships offer varying award amounts, which range from \$100 to \$5,000, depending on the size of the fund, the number of qualified applicants, and the wishes of the donors. Your letter announcing the award will include the scholarship amount.

CAN I APPLY IF I AM A 21ST CENTURY SCHOLAR?

Yes. If you are a 21st Century Scholar, be sure to know what amount of your tuition is covered by 21st Century to share in the Student Financial Information section.

IS IT REQUIRED THAT I SHARE MY FINANCIAL INFORMATION?

You must fill out all sections to submit the Universal Application, but applicants have the ability to opt out of applying for financial need scholarships if they do not wish to share financial information with committees.

CAN I RECEIVE MORE THAN ONE SCHOLARSHIP?

It is possible to receive more than one scholarship and HCCF encourages students to apply for all scholarships for which they meet the eligibility requirements.

CAN I USE MY SCHOLARSHIP AT ANY COLLEGE?

No. Some scholarships are more specific about what universities they can be paid to, such as those only for Indiana colleges or Purdue University or Indiana State University. Each scholarship gives details about its requirements regarding which school(s) the scholarship money can be used.

WHAT IF I CHANGE COLLEGES?

If you are awarded a scholarship, please contact HCCF ASAP with your updated college information and student ID number so checks can be sent to the correct school, whether it is before your freshman year begins or in the middle of your college career.

ARE SCHOLARSHIPS RENEWABLE?

Most HCCF scholarships are one-time awards unless noted in the scholarship amount on pages 8-43.

WHEN WILL I BE NOTIFIED?

High school recipients will be notified during Honor Programs at their schools. Spring college applicants will be notified via letter mid-May. Summer college applicants will be notified via letter mid-June.

WHAT ARE MY RESPONSIBILITIES IF I RECEIVE A SCHOLARSHIP?

You will receive a letter and be required to complete a form verifying the college/university attending as well as your student I.D. so the scholarship check can be sent. We also encourage you to send a thank you note to the donor via HCCF. Checks will NOT be sent to your school for fall until the verification form is completed and returned to HCCF.

IF I AM AWARDED A SCHOLARSHIP, DO I GET THE CHECK?

No. Award checks are made payable to the institution and prior to the beginning of the fall semester. Payments will be made in one installment at the beginning of the fall semester, to be split evenly for the school year by your school. Unspent funds should be returned to HCCF.

WHAT IF I HAVE ADDITIONAL QUESTIONS?

Scholarships for Non-Traditional Students

Established by generous donors, the Henry County Community Foundation has multiple scholarships that benefit non-traditional and adult students who have had a break in their post-secondary education for a year or more.

Students may have been delayed from schooling due to full-time employment, family responsibilities, military service, or have a High School Equivalency (H.S.E.) degree, and all are encouraged to apply.

The following scholarships are open to non-traditional students through HCCF at www.henrycountycf.org. Because some funds are also open to current graduating seniors, they may be due in February or June, so please see the scholarship listing for full details. Deadlines are also listed on our website under the "Scholarship Search" tab and posted with each scholarship.

THESE SCHOLARSHIPS ARE AVAILABLE TO NON-TRADITIONAL STUDENTS:

MARY LOVELY BRUMBACK SCHOLARSHIP

Established in memory of Mary Kendall Lovely Brumback, this scholarship is for a Henry County resident who has had their education interrupted for a year or more to attend a 2- or 4-year accredited college or university and pursue a teaching degree with financial need considered. Due in February. (Full description on page 11)

MARY G. FULLER SCHOLARSHIP

William Fuller established this scholarship in honor of his mother, Mary G. Fuller, who was a nurse at Henry County Hospital in the 1950s and 1960s. This scholarship will be awarded to New Castle residents attending Ivy Tech Community College to pursue a degree in nursing and have been raised in a single-parent home. Financial need will be considered. Due in February. (Full description on page 17)

IRENE BOVENDER WADE HUNLEY MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

The family of long-time New Castle resident, Irene Bovender Wade Hunley, has established a renewable scholarship in her memory for New Castle High School graduating seniors or graduates as well as non-traditional students wishing to further their education. Students must exhibit financial need and provide an essay noting the importance of hard work, honoring commitments, giving back to others, and the role faith plays in achieving happiness. Special consideration will be given to students pursuing beauty/cosmetology, studying piano or dance, members of New Castle First Baptist Church, worked at hospital or nursing home, on the swim team for 4 years in high school, or those who have an immediate family member in the military. Due in February. (Full description on page 20)

FRANCIS & MARIAN MUNDELL SCHOLARSHIP

Francis and Marian Mundell set up this fund to provide scholarships to graduates of Shenandoah High School who are 24 years or older, are residents of Henry County and wish to attend an accredited college or university in pursuit of a certificate or degree in nursing. Due in June. (Full description on page 27)

OPPORTUNITIES UNLIMITED SCHOLARSHIP

Established in 2003, this fund provides scholarships for seniors of any Henry County high school, post-graduates, or high school equivalency (H.S.E.) recipients for continuing education at any vocational school, accredited college or university whether pursuing a degree or certification. Students can reapply each school year. Due in June. (Full description on page 31)

RAY PAVY SPIRIT SCHOLARSHIP

This scholarship honors Ray Pavy and is available to traditional and non-traditional college students attending the Ivy Tech Community College Henry County campus. Students must have a 2.5 GPA or higher and may reapply for aid each semester they attend classes at the Ivy Tech Community College Henry County campus or are enrolled in online courses as required by Ivy Tech. Due in June. (Full description on page 32)

ALFORD FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

Description: The Alford Family Scholarship Fund was created to honor Sam Alford for his contributions to New Castle High School and the New Castle community. The purpose of the scholarship fund is to benefit young men and women and to enable them to further their formal education.

Qualifications: Applicants must: 1) be graduating seniors at New Castle High School; 2) have a 2.3⁺ GPA; and 3) exhibit financial need.

Required Supporting Materials: 1) Most recent school transcript; 2) College acceptance letter; 3) Completed financial section; and 4) Two letters of recommendation submitted through the online application.

Scholarship Amount: 1 Scholarship

HERBERT & HALLIE AXE SCHOLARSHIP

Description: Herb and Hallie Axe were a unique couple always having a love for their community and for others. Deeply involved in different service clubs in New Castle, Herb also showed his love for basketball by holding a season ticket for Trojan basketball games. Hallie was an outstanding cook and known for her rhubarb pies. They enjoyed traveling and visited the Holy Land several times. Members of the First United Methodist Church, they were faithful in helping others and living out their faith. One of the things they valued most was education and through their wills established this scholarship fund.

Qualifications: Applicants must: 1) be graduating seniors at New Castle High School; 2) have a 3.0⁺ GPA; and 3) exhibit financial need.

Required Supporting Materials: 1) Most recent school transcript; 2) College acceptance letter; 3) Completed financial section; and 4) Two letters of recommendation submitted through the online application.

Scholarship Amount: 1 Scholarship

BASLER FAMILY SCHOLARSHIP

Description: The fund was established by the family of Jack Basler, who was administrator for Henry County Memorial Hospital. He and his wife Paula had three children, who were all New Castle High School Graduates. The family established the scholarship with the hopes of helping students with their collegiate careers for years to come.

Qualifications: Applicants must: 1) be graduating seniors at New Castle High School.

Required Supporting Materials: 1) Most recent school transcript; 2) College acceptance letter; and 3) Two letters of recommendation submitted through the online application.

Scholarship Amount: 1 Scholarship

JOSEPH RUSSELL BIMBER SCHOLARSHIP

Description: Joseph Russell Bimber was born March 26, 2001, and lived long enough to make an impact on the lives of others. Medical experts had given up hope on Joseph living to be born, it was in his four hours of life that his parents and other family members got to meet and hold him before he lost his fight with Spina Bifida and Trisomy 18. "The scholarship is a way to keep his name and our memories of him alive," says Joseph's mother.

Qualifications: Applicants must: 1) be graduating seniors of Tri Jr.-Sr. High School; 2) have a 3.0+ GPA; 3) major in education or school counseling; and 4) pursue a 4-year degree.

Required Supporting Materials: 1) Most recent school transcript; 2) College acceptance letter; and 3) Two letters of recommendation submitted through the online application.

Scholarship Amount: 1 Scholarship

BIRDS EYE FOODS (BROOKS FOODS) SCHOLARSHIP

Description: This scholarship was established for the benefit of Henry County students who wish to attend an accredited college or university located in Indiana and major in Food Processing or Agri-Business or a related field of study.

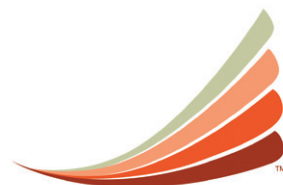
